Keep in mind that we are expecting the El Nino beginning in January. This may have an effect if you are going to plant seeds but not so much if seedlings are your beginning.

THOUGHTS

Being on the Steering Committee of Common Ground is a true honor. We do need your help! In order to make this a family experience we want your input as to what you, the gardeners, want. We sent missives to the members but do not get responses, it's frustrating. Success of the garden is dependent on YOU.

COMPOST AND SOIL

Compost is a great addition to your plot any time. Loam, what is loam? It is. a great growing medium but usually is used in the same

sentence as top soil, but it's not. Loam has to contain organic matter(clippings, decaying root fibers, worm castings, etc.) Loam should be a ratio of: 40% sand; 40% silt(organic); and 20% clay. Let it lie fallow for a couple of weeks and there is a great seed bed. Remember to rotate your crops, don't plant the same thing in the same location.

WHAT DO WE GROW NOW?

What to plant? Cool season edibles include Lettuce, onions, leeks, carrots, beets, peas and chard. For color try pansies, sweet peas, snapdragons, and stock.
